## EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT BETWEEN SCOTT CROSBY AND THE WEXFORD-MISSAUKEE BOARD OF EDUCATION

THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into as of the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2012, between the Board of Education of the Wexford-Missaukee Intermediate School District, hereinafter referred to as the "Board of Education", and Scott Crosby, as Superintendent, hereinafter referred to as Administrator.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education at a regular meeting held on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2012, approved the employment of the Administrator as in accordance with the terms and conditions of this contract; and

WHEREAS, the Administrator desires to be employed by the Board of Education in accordance with the terms and conditions of this contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained in this contract, it is agreed between the parties, as follows:

- 1. <u>TERM</u>: This contract will be a one year contract renewable annually and shall take effect on the First day of July, 2012, and continue in force thereafter through the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2013.
- 2. <u>DUTIES</u>: The administrator agrees to perform assigned duties in a competent and professional manner in compliance with the laws applicable to the school district and the policies and regulations adopted by the Board of Education. The work year is 52 weeks. The work schedule will follow the school calendar during the school year with administrators receiving the same holidays and recesses as the professional staff.
- 3. <u>EVALUATION</u>: Consistent with the Policies set forth by the Board of Education and Administrative Regulations.
- 4. <u>TENURE EXCLUSION</u>: This contract does not confer tenure upon the administrator in the position of administrator or any other position in the district.
- 5. <u>COMPENSATION</u>: The salary will be \$103,805 for fiscal year 2012-13. The salary shall be paid in 26 equal installments. The Board of Education retains the right to adjust the salary during the continuation of this contract in future years.

- 6. ONE TIME PAYMENT: The administrator shall receive a one-time \$1,000 payment included with the first November 2012 paycheck. The payment does not become part of the administrator's base salary.
- 7. <u>ANNUITY</u>: The Superintendent may annually approve payment of up to \$3,500 for 2012-13 and thereafter in an annuity of the administrator's choosing, to be paid during the fiscal year, if the following conditions are met:
  - A. The administrator must apply for the annuity before the end of the fiscal year. The application will be based upon the efforts the administrator has made in the previous fiscal year. For example, payments in 2012-13 will be based upon activities approved during the 2011-12 fiscal year.
  - B. The administrator must have participated in leadership activities related to his/her position, but that extend beyond the scope of the actual requirements of the job. Examples of such leadership activities include, but are not limited to:
    - 1. Serving as an officer in a state or national organization related to education.
    - 2. Garnering revenue for the ISD through Federal and/or State grants.
    - 3. Establishing innovative programs for students, staff, and/or local school district administrators/staff.
    - 4. Presenting at State or National Conference(s).
    - 5. Writing an article that is published in a national educational journal.
- 8. <u>BENEFITS</u>: During the term of this contract, the administrator shall receive benefits as follows in accordance with Board of Education policy (including 9 days per year, accumulative to 120 days of sick leave, 2 personal days, disability leave, health insurance, and retirement benefits) subject to the following limitations: 1) this paragraph excludes any compensation or benefit specifically set forth elsewhere in this contract; and 2) such benefits are subject to change at any time on the same basis as changed for other salaried full-time staff.

<u>Life Insurance</u>: The Board shall furnish a term life insurance policy with benefits equal to one year's salary of the administrator's contract.

<u>Service Purchase for Employee Retirement</u>: The district will provide \$4,748.69 toward the purchase of retirement credit or other retirement options for each year worked as an administrator for the district.

<u>Health Plan Benefits</u>: Blue Cross Blue Shield Community Blue medical insurance and other insurance benefits as amended with a Health Reimbursement Account to partially cover deductible amounts incurred.

<u>Vacation</u>: The administrator is entitled to twenty-two days of paid vacation each year during the course of this contract. Unused vacation days may be allowed to accumulate up to a limit of 60 days. The administrator will be

reimbursed at the end of each fiscal year for a maximum of three unused vacation days.

<u>Sick Leave</u>: Nine sick days will be awarded administrators on the date of hire, and thereafter, 9 sick days will be added annually upon the first day of each new contract year. Sick leave may be accumulated to a maximum of 120 days. To qualify for sick leave administrators may be required to present a doctor's signed statement or a signed self-statement.

Compensation for Unused Sick Leave: After 11 years of continuous service to the ISD and upon retirement into the Michigan School Employee Retirement System the administrator shall be compensated for unused sick days at the prevailing daily rate of pay for a substitute teacher up to a total amount not to exceed \$9,600.

<u>Personal Business Days</u>: Two days per school year to be used for personal business will be awarded to administrators upon the first day of each new contract year. These personal business days will not accumulate from one contract year to another. Unused personal business days will be reimbursed at the rate of \$80 per day and included with pay in June of each year.

<u>Funeral Leave Days</u>: Up to 2 paid funeral leave days, not deducted from any other leave time, will be granted in case of death in the immediate family. Immediate family shall be defined as: Spouse, children, stepchildren, parents, siblings, in-laws, grandchildren, grandparents, or dependents living in the same household of said Employee. An additional two (2) paid days may be allowed for travel time, upon prior approval by the Superintendent. Employees may use sick leave days to attend the funeral of a close friend or relative with the approval of the Board President.

<u>Snow Days</u>: The administrator is expected to work unless excused by the Superintendent because of the severity of the storm.

9. <u>Termination</u>: Throughout the term of this contract the administrator shall be subject to discharge for good and just causes provided, however, that the Board shall not arbitrarily or capriciously call for dismissal, and the administrator shall be entitled to receive written charges, notices of hearing, and a fair hearing before the Board of Education before being discharged. Said hearing shall be public or private at the option of the administrator, and she/he shall be entitled to have legal counsel at his/her own expense.

Upon written notification of retirement from the school district by the first Monday in March of the calendar year of retirement, the administrator will be eligible for a \$ 1,000 retirement notification payment. It is understood that the administrator must work through June 30 of the retirement year to be eligible for the retirement notification payment.

Should the cooperative agreement between Manistee ISD and Wexford – Missaukee ISD be terminated for any reason the administrator's contract will revert to the pro-rated portion of the contract agreed to and signed on June 2, 2009.

- 9. In order to promote professional growth and development, the administrator will be eligible for tuition reimbursement for up to three (3) graduate credits per contract year. The credits must be for classes approved in advance by the Superintendent.
- 10. <u>SPECIAL PROVISIONS</u>: The Board shall reimburse the administrator \$350 per month for use of personal vehicle in conducting business outside of the district in accordance with the position, or the Board shall provide an automobile for such travel.

The Board shall reimburse the administrator at his/her per diem rate for all vacation days accrued but not used upon his/her retirement or termination of employment.

This document must be signed and returned to the Superintendent of Wexford-Missaukee Intermediate School District within 10 days of issuance or all provisions of the contract are null and void.
