#### **Nutrition Services:**

2019-2020 School Year: Step Credit upon eligibility. Off schedule signing bonus payment equivalent to two days' pay for employees at top step, and one day's pay for employees not advancing to a new experience tier (employees who have achieved the After 1 Yr rate, but are not moving to the After 5 Yrs rate), payable the second pay in February.

#### Maintenance:

2019-2020 School Year: Step Credit upon eligibility.

#### 5. Technician Classifications:

- A. The Classifications of HVAC, Master Plumber, and Master Electrician shall only be assigned to those employees who have retained full licensure(s) and/or certification(s) to perform said work.
- B. Should an employee in Department Group #2, either allow their certification(s) and or licensure(s) to expire or in the event a new employee is hired and lacks the proper certification(s) and/or licensure(s) as determined by the Board, the employee shall be placed in the according "Technician" classification, i.e. HVAC.
- C. Should any employee in a technician(s) positions listed above, obtain full certification and/or licensure as determined by the Board, then the employee shall be moved into the applicable classification. However, at any given time, the district will maintain enly-no more than three (3) licensed/certified HVAC mechanics, one (1) Master Plumber, and one (1) Master Electrician.
