RECOMMENDATION

Based on the factors described above, the Michigan Economic Development Corporation recommends a 100 percent employment tax credit for 10 years for up to 700 net new employees in excess of the company's established base of . Should the company fail to secure approved local support (e.g. a property tax abatement), the credit percentage will be lowered to 80 percent.
